1. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: I need fleet vehicles this year. When should I order?

A: Order now! If possible, please enter your orders **by August 11**.

Be sure to notify your GM Fleet Account Manager if you plan to order in time for the August Allocation Cycle.

Q: If I enter a fleet factory order, am I eligible for Price Protection?

A: Yes! GM is offering 2026MY Price Protection based on the **date the factory order is entered in GM's system**.
(Subject to change)

Q: How can I avoid price increases throughout the model year?

A: GM recommends entering factory orders early to avoid price increases.

Q: I want today's pricing, but need delivery in the future (such as Q1). Is this possible?

A: For most models, yes.

Customers request delayed Target Production Weeks ("TPWs") to help schedule production for a later date.

Q: What are Delayed Target Production Weeks (TPWs)?

A: Dealers and Fleet Management Companies can use delayed Requested TPWs when entering orders.
This allows orders to be placed now but produced at a later time.

NOTE: Delayed Requested TPWs are not guaranteed and are treated as requests by the plant.

Q: When will pricing be available for 2026 model year?

A: - Pricing for many 2026 models is already available, including:

Half Ton (1500 series) trucks

Chevrolet Equinox, Traverse, Trailblazer, Trax; GMC Terrain, Acadia; Buick Enclave, Encore GX & Envista

Electric Vehicles: Equinox EV, Blazer EV, Silverado EV

- Pricing for HD Trucks and Colorado & Canyon will be available soon.

- Pricing for late-introduction models (Tahoe, Suburban, Yukon/XL, Vans) will be announced at a later date.

Q: When do Order Banks open for 2026MY fleet vehicles?

A: Order banks are **already open** for most models. (Vans will open later this year.)

2. 2026MY Order to Delivery Timing

- For many models, the **average order-to-delivery timing is approx. 16 weeks (4 months)**.
- This is a general guideline; actual timing may vary by model, production constraints, and demand vs. allocation.
 - o Some models can take of 6+ months to deliver. Please consult with your GM Enolve Account Manager for models-specific guidance.

Allocation Cycle	GM Canada is entering into the August Allocation Cycle .
Order Timing	Orders entered by August 11th are likely to be scheduled during this cycle.* * This depends on constraints that may affect our ability to produce orders. * This also depends on the demand vs allocation, based on order volume.
Production Scheduling	Orders accepted for many models during the August Allocation cycle are likely to be produced between the weeks of Mid-September to Mid-October .
Shipping Timelines	Once a vehicle is produced and gets on rail, the average transit days are approx. 30+ days to arrive at the dealership, depending on location.
What does this mean?	Orders placed now are likely to arrive by the end of the year.

3. 2025MY Express & Savana Vans: LAST CALL

As we approach the end of the 2025 model year for Express and Savana vans, this is your...

LAST CALL for 2025MY Express & Savana Van Production

IMPORTANT: 2026MY vans do not start production until mid-November.
This is your last chance to receive a cargo van this year.

2025MY Production Constraints / Built-Out Equipment:

Cargo Vans:

- G80 Heavy-duty locking rear differential (constrained to 17% of production)
- A18 Rear cargo door windows swing-out glass (built out)
- A19 Swing-out rear side door window glass (built out)
- C69 Air conditioning, rear, includes (C36) rear heater (built out)
- C49 Defogger, rear-window electric (built out)
- ZP6 5-passenger Express Crew Van Package (built out)
- Y3H Paratransit Package (built out)
- YF2 Ambulance Package (built out)

Cutaway Vans:

- G80 Heavy-duty locking rear differential (constrained to 17% of production)
- YF2 Still available on cutaways only; ideal for ambulance configurations
